

Our fleet of mobile safety camera vans use police-approved vehicle detection systems to capture instances of dangerous driving, while providing a conspicuous visual deterrent and actively changing the way people drive through road works and on diversion routes.

On-board wi-fi means that data is uploaded to the cloud. Our trained SafetyCam operatives generate reports of traffic management incursions and speeding that can be viewed remotely by the client, for swift resolution and potential prosecution.

Be SAFE culture

Our high standards of health and safety are demonstrated by our 14 consecutive RoSPA Gold Awards. Our employees know that they have the backing of the directors to STOP WORK if they feel unsafe.

Employee wellbeing

Workforce support is ingrained through our management ethos and 'just culture'. Meanwhile we have an EAP, have trained almost 10% of our workforce as mental health first aiders and deliver several initiatives throughout the year that encourage people to Speak Out.

Best practice approach

In 2023 we were shortlisted by National Highways for 'Excellence in safety learning and culture' at their annual awards. This highlighted several initiatives which have driven continuous safety improvement and an increased safety maturity.



Local people resource

Our teams are based around several regional hubs of activity to minimise the need for travelling and staying away from home. This gives us flexibility and efficiency as well as cost, carbon and mental health benefits.

Development focused

In 2022/23 our employees averaged over 16 days of training. External training such as City & Guilds and NVQs accounted for over half of this, while the creation of learning pathways on the iHasco platform has delivered an improvement of soft skills across the workforce.

Engagement culture

Effective communication with our teams is important to make sure they are receiving key messages that help them work safe and considerately. We undertake several anonymous surveys a year to understand and improve our engagement.



Carbon conscious

Several of our innovations such as StoneMaster and EcoSite are designed to minimise carbon emissions. Our Carbon Management Plan details the improvements we have made in GHG reduction. We also hold ISO 14001 Environmental Management certs.

Understanding local needs

Our social value initiatives are based around research into community wants and needs, ensuring we use our particular skills to provide a legacy. `We have SVQM Bronze certification and in 2023 we spent over 2,500 hours in the community.

Responsible procurement
