Foreword

As a company our mission is to accelerate the energy transition and I am proud of the steps we have taken in 2023 to pursue this.

Through connecting customers with suppliers at scale in renewable energy products and services in the UK, the Netherlands, Belgium, the USA and Japan, iChoosr is helping turn the dial on the energy transition. In all regions we will this year reach the 2,000,000 milestone for solar panels installed through our schemes.

Here in the UK, our Solar Together schemes continue to grow and are responsible for more than 10% of MCS certified installations across the 23 regions where Solar Together has run. New county councils and combined authorities are launching their first schemes as many others continue to run repeat schemes year in year out.

While 2023 saw the energy switching market open up a fraction, it remains a long way short of previous switching levels while energy suppliers have not universally returned to compelling acquisition fixed tariffs. Our ambitions are not limited to energy switching and PV/storage installations.

We are working hard to launch into new areas of renewable products and services.

About us

We are iChoosr, experts in engaging people to purchase sustainable energy products and contribute towards the energy transition. With iChoosr, consumers and suppliers are brought together on a large scale to help people make an informed decision where they might otherwise not act.

We have been engaging consumers via group-buying schemes in collaboration with councils and other community leaders in the UK since 2012. Starting with collective energy switching, we added Solar Together, our group-buying scheme for solar PV and storage, in 2015.

In the years since then we have partnered with over 210 councils to carry out energy switching and solar auctions to bring consumers and suppliers together.

The iChoosr **approach:** providing a safe environment to make an informed choice

The power of group buying can be harnessed by engaging a group to come together so that its collective buying power can be shared. The iChoosr approach is to make this as easy and hassle-free as possible.

As experts, we spend a lot of time looking into the reasons why people are not doing something they know deep down might be the right thing for them to do. Whether it is taking the time to find a better energy tariff, or finally looking into all the different options for those solar panels they may have been thinking about for a few years.

Breaking down what happens between where people are now and their desired outcome, we investigate the pains, gains, anxieties, and habits that stand between the two. Through detailed and repeated consumer research we uncover real human insights to help people take action.

Common reasons people feel unable to act are:

The iChoosr model reduces the perceived barriers to action and throughout our customer journey we put the customer firmly in control of their decision. By providing people with enough information at every stage, we take away the hassle and enable people to take charge.

The iChoosr process

The general approach for our energy and solar schemes is the same – a simple five-step process that we have perfected over the years across business lines in Europe, North America and Asia. The energy and solar schemes do have some important differences, which we have outlined below.





Sign UpRegistration is free and without obligation.





Auction

We hold an auction amongst pre-vetted suppliers, which compete with their best offers.





Personal Offer

Residents receive a detailed but easy to understand personal offer that is obligation free.





You Decide

Residents decide if they want to accept their offer – our dedicated support team are always on hand to answer any questions. Solar



Roof Survey

Before the installation is finalised, the winning installer will survey their roof to check if the recommended number of panels will fit and if the expected generation will be reached.



Installation

After the resident approves their survey report, their installation can take place. They will then have a complete and working solar PV system installed on their roof.



Generating their own renewable energy

After installation, residents will benefit by saving money on their electricity bills and generating their own renewable energy.

Take control of energy costs

We will handle the entire switching process for residents, so they don't have to do anything. They will then be one of the thousands who have taken control of their energy costs through our collective energy switches.

Energy switching for people without internet access

We work closely with our partners to allow residents without internet access to take part in our energy scheme where possible.

We enable residents to register 'offline' for our energy schemes and provide them with an offer letter instead of an offer email. This means that more residents are able to benefit from collective action.

Where we work

Over the last twelve years, we have worked with over 160 Councils across the UK. We continue to work with over a hundred councils across the UK on energy and solar projects.



Solar Together: Group-buying for Solar Panels

This year more UK residents than ever before have opted to install solar and storage through a Solar Together scheme. Almost 13,000 solar PV installations were completed through Solar Together in 2023 meaning the scheme has contributed just over 10% of the domestic solar PV installations registered with MCS in England.

With the cost of household bills a priority for homeowners, 2023 has been a year of uncertainty for many, and Solar Together has continued to offer a way for residents to take control of costs by increasing their independence from the grid and reducing carbon emissions.

The solar and storage market can be complex to navigate alone, with many residents taking this step for the first and only time. New products are entering the market every month from established and new brands, and in response to increased demand, many new installation businesses have also entered the market. Solar Together provides the reassurance of a competitive, high-quality offer from a trusted vetted installer.

Not only does Solar Together offer residents the reassurance that products and installation businesses have been vetted and measured against pre-defined quality standards, but it also offers residents support at all stages of the process before and after installation. We work with industry bodies such as MCS and RECC to ensure customers in Solar Together schemes are better protected than customers engaging with the market alone, and this year our commitment to customer protection has included delivering resolutions for a small number of customers impacted by an installer ceasing to trade.

As we move into 2024 we continue to develop processes and build on the learnings from 2023. We have grown the Solar Together team, and we expect to support more councils and combined authorities in launching Solar Together schemes for the first time, as well as continuing to grow and develop schemes in repeat regions to increase solar uptake around the UK.

Solar Together offers the councils we work with a straightforward and cost effective way to make a significant impact on carbon reduction targets through private resident investment in renewable energy generation.

Solar Together group-buying schemes make it easy for British homeowners to install solar panels and storage for a competitive price with a trustworthy, vetted installer.

iChoosr has been organising group-buying schemes for solar panels in the Netherlands and Belgium since 2013. And our UK schemes have resulted in over 293,000 panels since 2018, delivering carbon reduction that equates to over 313,000 cars being taken off the road.

Over the last seven years, iChoosr has delivered 51 Solar Together schemes in partnership with County Councils, Combined Authorities and Unitary Authorities across the UK. Regions where schemes have been delivered include in the South East, South West, Central and Northern England and the Midlands. With many of the councils now entering their fifth or sixth year of the scheme, we are seeing growing interest and numbers of installations in regions where schemes are repeated year on year.

Solar Together in 2023

As the UK's energy crisis continues to grip households, residents continue to seek alternative energy sources to find security from rising electricity costs, reduce their reliance on the grid and generate their own clean energy.

The reduction to 0% VAT for energy-saving material installations in residential properties also continues to help make the installation of solar PV very attractive to residents. This also rolls out to cover standalone retrofit batteries in 2024 so we expect the impact of this measure to support further growth in future schemes.

In 2023, we launched Solar Together in three new regions; Cheshire & Warrington, Worcestershire and Berkshire. We grew schemes in repeating regions, with Solar Together Norfolk running for a seventh successful year and both Suffolk and Essex County Councils participating for a sixth time in 2023. As well as these many other councils repeated annual schemes with great success and increased engagement from residents including repeat participation from residents that previously installed solar taking up the option to retrofit battery storage.



Battery Storage

In 2023 schemes, we continued to include optional battery storage and saw 90% of residents add a battery to their solar PV system. Due to the continued popularity of this add-on, we will keep supporting participants in our schemes by offering clear information and tools to help people make a well-informed decision about installing solar and storage in their home.



Electric Vehicle Charging

In 2023, we continued to provide residents with the option to install an electric vehicle charging point as part of their solar installations. Approximately 40% of registrants indicated this option was of interest to them, with nearly 400 electric vehicle charging points installed in 2023.


