Background

A consortium including Walsh Investors LLC, Vinci Concessions, and Bilfinger Project Investments designed, built, financed, and operated the Lewis Clark Bridge (East End Crossing) over the Ohio River under the oversight of the Indiana Finance Authority. This cable-stay bridge, which opened in December 2016, spans seven miles of roadway and encompasses over 900 associated assets.

They collaborated closely with the project team, and AMX was approved to meet the client's needs within eight weeks of the new proposal.



CASE STUDY

Background

In 2012, British Waterways split into two organisations: The Canal and River Trust for England and Wales and Scottish Canals for Scotland. Scottish Canals, responsible for 137 miles of waterway, needed to update its asset management software after the split. The goal was to incorporate new principles like ISO 55000, flexible reporting, and advancements in mobile technology to manage their diverse assets effectively.
