Risk Assessment Brief for an Exhibition

Objective:

To identify, evaluate, and mitigate potential risks associated with hosting an exhibition, ensuring the safety of participants, staff, and visitors, and compliance with legal and organizational standards.

Scope:

The risk assessment will cover all aspects of the exhibition, including the setup, operation, and breakdown phases. Key areas of focus will include:

Venue Safety:

Structural integrity and fire safety compliance.

Emergency exits, signage, and evacuation plans.

Exhibition Activities:

Hazards related to exhibits, interactive displays, or demonstrations.

Potential risks from electrical equipment or machinery.

Crowd Management:

Overcrowding prevention and traffic flow management.

Emergency response measures for large gatherings.

Contractor and Staff Safety:

Proper use of equipment and tools during setup and takedown.

Adequate training and use of personal protective equipment (PPE).

Health and Hygiene:

Sanitation and cleanliness of facilities.

First aid availability and response protocols.

External Factors:

Weather-related risks (for outdoor exhibitions).

Transportation and parking hazards.

Deliverables:

The assessment will include:

A comprehensive risk register categorizing identified risks by severity and likelihood.

Mitigation strategies and action plans to reduce or eliminate risks.

Recommendations for ongoing monitoring and incident response.

Timeline:

The risk assessment will be conducted two weeks prior to the exhibition's commencement to allow ample time for implementing recommendations.

Responsibility:

The risk assessment team will liaise with the exhibition organizers, venue management, and contractors to gather information and coordinate safety measures effectively.
