Use lifting aids (trolleys) / Team lifts for bulky, oversized or overweight objects. Bend at the knee and lift with straight back. Avoid twisting when carrying loads. Carry packages with heaviest side close to the body. Avoid carrying up and down staircases where possible. Utilize lifts where possible.	1	3	3
