

We work with all industries to match and prepare candidates for vacancies, enabling businesses to build and retain a talented, inclusive workforce.



Youth programmes

Our youth programmes provide young people with skills for life and work. Whether its helping people find the right career path through education, training and work, or supporting personal development, we provide opportunities to help young people thrive.

We delivered the National Citizen Service (NCS) for more than 10 years, giving young people a unique experience of adventure and discovery, through outward bounds, independent living experiences, life skills, volunteering and social action projects.

Today, we deliver Positive Pathways on behalf of the Youth Endowment Fund to support young people who are at risk of offending or have already offended. 66

Justice programmes

Our justice programmes enable people in contact with the criminal justice system to transform their lives. We aim to break the cycle of re-offending and create safer communities through responsive resettlement services and rehabilitative interventions, including support for people to enter mainstream services, education, and employment.

Our programmes, including CFO Evolution and Commissioned Rehabilitative Services, work in partnership with the Probation Service and charity partners to address a wide range of individual needs and enable successful transitions back into the community.

Health & Wellbeing

Our health & wellbeing services enable people to lead happy, healthy and independent lives. We help people adopt better behaviours and access the right support to improve or manage their physical and mental wellbeing.

Able Futures provides nine months of confidential, no cost advice, guidance and support from mental health professionals to help people cope with work while managing a mental health condition such as anxiety, depression or stress.

Our team of healthcare professionals provide health assessments on behalf of the Department for Work and Pensions.
