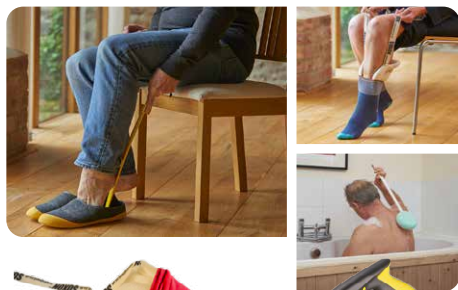

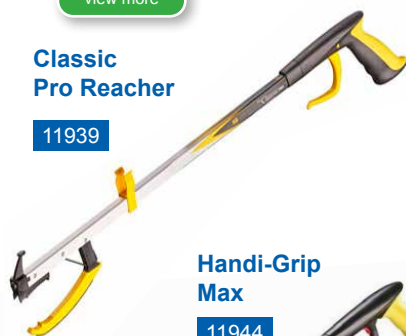

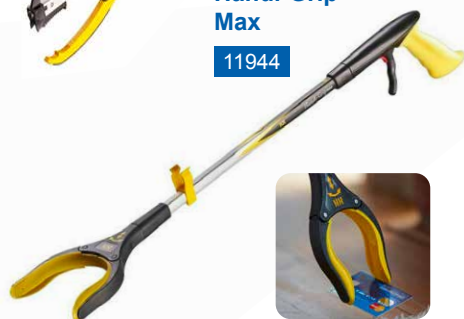

If you have a disability or experience difficulty completing daily tasks, you have a couple of options:

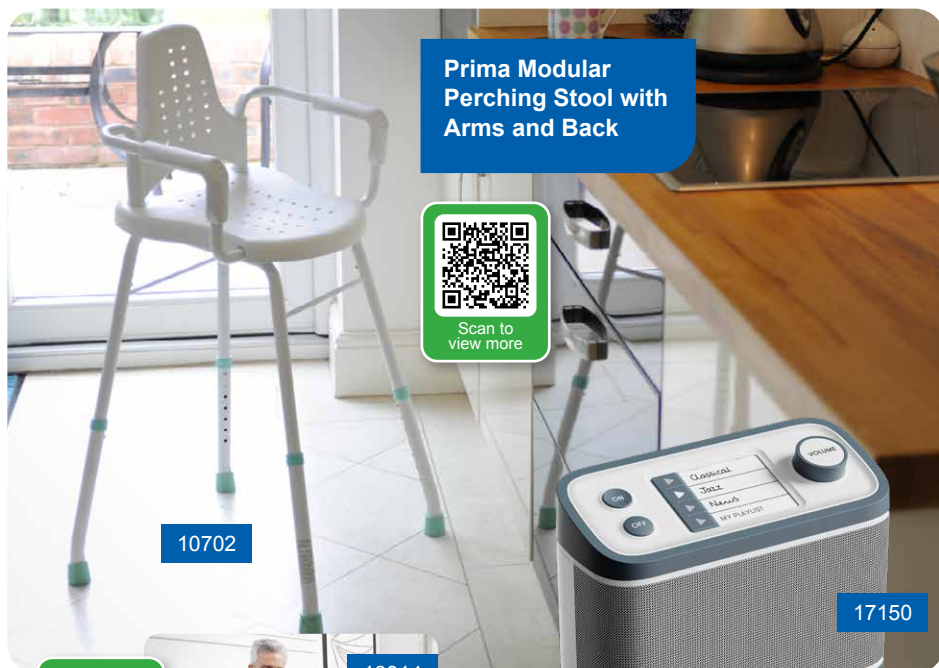
- ***Self-care by purchasing equipment***

Medequip can support you with self-care options, such as purchasing equipment from an extensive range of products to aid independent daily living via our online retail website www.manageathome.co.uk

This could be a mobility aid to help moving around or transferring into a bath, or simply a more ergonomic utensil that is easier to use and hold than a typical design. Products also include rollators, over bed tables, grab rails, walking aids, wheelchairs, support cushions, bath lifts, bath seats and boards, raised toilet seats, commodes, electric profiling beds, riser recliner chairs and aids for dressing and eating.

If your needs are more complex and you require long-term support, you may be eligible for an assessment. Healthcare professionals such as occupational therapists can work with you to find ways of managing tasks and offering advice and potential solutions. Equipment would be prescribed and loaned to you through your local Community Equipment Loan Service.

Around the Home

Accessing Loan Equipment through Health and Social Care Services

To access equipment on loan from your local authority and the NHS you will need to have an assessment.

You can ask your GP for a referral or request help by visiting your local Council's social care webpage and using their contact information - this could be by telephone, text relay, email or an online referral form.

Healthcare professionals will work with you to:

- *Assess your difficulties carrying out everyday living tasks*
- *Advise you on different ways to manage tasks*
- *Loan essential equipment to help complete daily tasks*

Depending on your situation, a care and support assessment may include how you:

- *Get in and out of bed or chair*
- *Get on and off the toilet*
- *Dress yourself*
- *Feed yourself*
- *Manage the stairs*
- *Prepare drinks, snack and/or meals*

The assessment may also cover:

- *Your eligibility for minor and major adaptations to your home*
- *Provide advice and information about other services*
